The Dolomites are one of our planet's most gorgeous spots. With their high peaks and vigorous nature they represent a unique beauty that has been recognized by UNESCO and added to the list of World Heritage.

Nature's highlights are complemented by highest standards in accommodation facilities: charming villages, luxurious hotels and chalets, a strong culture for gourmet and winemaking. In other words: you will feel welcomed and comfortably spoiled.





The **Dolomiti Superski** is the biggest ski resort in the world with over 1,200km perfectly groomed slopes - from the world famous Sellaronda ski tour - a 40km carousel that traverses 2 different regions, 3 provinces, 4 valleys - to many breathtaking views on the peaks of the Dolomite mountains, including the 3.343m high glacier Marmolada.



Many gorgeous huts can be found directly on the slopes, that offer the best food you can find worldwide while skiing: extraordinary quality and culinary proposals are a priority for local businesses.









DAY 1

Welcome to Alta Badia in the heart of the Dolomites!

Check in at your alpine-style hotel and cozy up around the open fire in this cozy atmosphere.

Get ready for your first culinary experience, where Italian and Tyrolean cuisine meet for a unique mix of cultures, tastes and habits.







DAY 2 Meet your guide and discover Alta Badia ski area

Your private instructor will meet you at your hotel and guide you through your first skiing days in the Dolomites. Today you will discover the area of Alta Badia, with its wide slopes and fantastic views. 130 km of perfectly groomed slopes are ready for you!



Lunch at one of the many little ski huts that offer a wide selection of local delicacies: *Knoedel, Schlutzkrapfen, Strudel, Speck* and much more to discover!











DAY 3 Cinque Torri, Lagazuoi, Scotoni

Today you will experience a very unique tour: with a short shuttle ride you will reach Passo Falzarego and ski from there to the iconic Cinque Torri just before Cortina d'Ampezzo.



Reach the top of Lagazuoi for an incredible view at 2.700m and make your way down the 8km slope to the gorgeous little hut Scotoni, famous for its grilled dishes and local wine selection.



Ski down after lunch at get ready for another experience: get pulled by horses on the way back to Alta Badia.



Get back to the hotel and enjoy a well-deserved time at the spa.



DAY 4

The world famous Sellaronda

Your private instructor will guide you through the famous ski carousel Sellaronda, that traverses 2 different regions, 3 provinces and 4 valleys in about 40 km slopes.

Today you will stop for lunch in a very cute little hut on top of Passo Sella, about half way through your trip - enjoy the incredible view from here!







Tonight, you will have a special dinner at a typical hut, including a transfer by snowcat!

Enjoy the traditional delicacies!











DAY 5

A 10.5km slope, tasting at 2.500m and a helicopter ride

Get ready for another amazing day!! Today with your instructor you will make your way to the adiacent Val Gardena valley, ski down the worldcup downhill slope Saslong and reach the top of Seceda mountain for an awesome shot.

After skiing the 10.5km *Longia* slope and heading up again, you will enjoy a private tasting of local delicacies and South Tyrolean wines in a secret cellar of one of the most stunning huts in the area with a breath-taking view!







Once you're finished jump on the helicopter that will land just over the hut and enjoy the view of the peaks at sundown while you fly back to Alta Badia! Little highlight: the Dolomites get pink during sundown and -rise!









DAY 6 Sass Dla Crusc and grand finale at Moritzino Hut

For your final day at Dolomiti Superski area discover the less busy area of Sass Dla Crusc, where an idillic little church can be visited.

Return to the heart of Alta Badia for a last lunch on the slopes - it will be unforgettable though!

Iconic Moritzino hut is reknown for its quality of fresh fish on the snow!
